- 3. The Anti-Racism Statement [Fall 2020] and Inclusion Statement [Spring 2021] were approved by Student Government, Faculty, Caucus, Senate, and Cabinet.
- 4. Core Workshop: The Psychology of Difficult Conversations. This workshop was held throughout the Spring Semester and during the Summer Institute.
- 5. Promote Diversity: The campus put up flags in six languages to make the campus feel more welcoming and inclusive. Also, via a survey, the campus has identified employees who would be willing to help with translation if needed.
