2. Chat with VP L. Kahler

- I. Address concerns about Executive Orders pertaining to DEI and other Academic issues
 - i. VP. L. Kahler attended <u>Chancellor Meeting on DEI.pdf</u> -he encourages faculty to read the document
 - 1. Message: Courts has put much of what is in executive orders on hold
 - 2. The adopted SUNY Board rules around graduation requirements regarding DEI, and every campus must have a DEI officer, and other DEI initiatives remain in place and SUNY will challenge to keep these requirements in place
 - 3. Chancellor does not want us to engage in "anticipatory overcompliance".
 - 4. We will comply with Federal Law, but we will not define Federal Law, so need further clarification before we can know where everything is going
 - 5. Our campus cannot act independently from SUNY
 - 6. Administration is watching closely
 - ii. Budget Season is here and taking up a lot of time
 - 1. President VanWagoner will be having open forums
 - Feeling better this year going into the budget cycle than any previous year. Still waiting for all budgets to come in to see exactly where we are

 but revenue generation, Fund Balance, assistance from the State, workforce development – are helping to generate a positive trend
 - iii. The Dean searches will commence soon
 - 1. Job openings will be posted soon
 - iv. Question/Comments:
 - Students, especially LGBTQ+ and Trans, are afraid is there messaging going out to students on this? *Response: will work with Dr. Marshall and* VP of Student Affairs Dr. Pine to craft a message to send out – Also, Dr. Marshall and VP of Students Affairs Dr. Pine will be going to Student Congress after Spring Break to talk to students (help give students assurance that they will have a safe space to study)
 - 2. Do we have programs for which funding can be pulled by the Federal Government? *Response: From initial analysis, outside of Title IV funding*

we don't see a place where if Federal funding was cut off that we would have much of an issue currently. Things can change, but as of now, it looks like other cuts could be manageable.
