RECOGNITION OF KRISTA HARTMAN

S. Frisbee motioned that the Senate recognize Krista Hartman for her years of service to the Senate (J. Bauman second). The resolution (attached) was approved unanimously.

#### **CITIZENSHIP**

B. Perrotti commented that community colleges should position their graduates to be better citizens. He suggested altering the College's mission statement to reflect that goal, and to incorporate citizenship and require voter registration into College Seminar. A discussion followed, including a concern about whether or not the College could require students to register to vote, and a suggestion that there could be a required DGV event instead, at which voter registration forms could be provided. There were also concerns that whomever was presenting the voting information would need to remain neutral and unbiased since the College receives federal funding for it students. One suggestion offered was to create a neutral video that could be shown to students. It was recommended that the conversation be forwarded to J. Dewan and G. St Croix.
