## PA Retirement Incentive Extension

- Crystal three employees took the PA incentive in December.
- All agreed to extending the (seven remaining slots) incentive until May.

## Remote Work Policy

- Clarified first step is a *remote work policy* with a long-term goal of a *flexible work policy*.
- Crystal has done considerable work preparing a list of considerations for the policy.
  - o One of the first priorities is to identify eligibility.
- Crystal will share considerations with Cabinet for discussion (at Friday's meeting and beyond).
- Consider bringing as a discussion item to the January Administrators' meeting.

#### Mentoring/volunteering
