## Summer camps/pool

- No testing for campers
- Pipeline programs green light for full capacity with social distancing, screening requirements.
- Athletic camps Review NJCAA, NYS, SUNY, CDC summer camp guidelines and proceed with the following in mind: aim for outdoor camps; masks required; encourage social distancing; required daily screening; enrollment max to should try to accommodate moving indoor in case of rain.
  - Lew High School leagues-ok to follow similar guidelines as Summer Camp protocol.
- CCED investigating using a tent for more outdoor capacity. Planning to proceed with reduced numbers.
- Pool NYS indicates the pool can be open. However, the dressing rooms cannot be used.
  - o Determined: As of right now, the MVCC pool will remain closed. However, MVCC will teach a lifeguard class at the Clinton pool.

### Checkpoint recommendation

- Tom shared the (mini) crisis/events team discussed and is proposing the elimination of the check-point effective May 14.
  - o All building doors need to be opened (ADA compliance)
  - o Potentially free up volunteers for testing;
  - o Free up ACC 116.
- If checkpoint is eliminated, signage will be increased.
  - Will still use the screening app.
  - o Consider increased/mandatory surveillance testing with employees.
- Potential cons: Removes ability to catch a sick individual; may decrease use of the screening app.
- Revisit at May 11 Cabinet meeting.
- Cabinet should revisit the on-campus capacity spreadsheet for June 1 staggered return.
