Values moments

Student lunches

Remote work policy

- Dependent care: Add language to indicate the policy is not intended for episodic instances.
 - Consider: *Remote work is not a substitute for dependent care. However, a child or elderly relative might also be at home with the remote worker, after school or during the day, as long as they are independently pursuing their own activities.*
