## Previous meeting summary - Jill

### Wellness/Organizational Development – David K.

- Wellness Council Update:
  - O Distributed a list of individuals (starting with classified front-line staff) who are interested in acquiring standing desks.
  - There is a small sum of money available in Jim Lynch's area for furniture (academic area).
  - Cabinet members will review the list and look for funding for those individuals in their respective areas.
  - o Delivery will need to be coordinated with facilities and IT.
