 - Bus passes
 - Immediate housing (temporary/long term)

- Note-taking- Students request notes from teachers. OAR can hire someone to take notes and hand them out anonymously.

- -Recording app (phone version and desktop version)
- -Phone app is free (to upgrade you have to pay)
- -School has a trial version for fall semester (a limited license given)
- -Suggest students to see if there is interest
- -Available on Windows or Mac
- -Tamara Mariotti- has to approve students to use it
- -Rachel Golden has 2 minute video how Sonocent works and will email it to everyone
- -Don't need permission but it is encouraged out of respect to ask professor to record notes
- -On desktop version you can import PowerPoints and audio is synced with the specific slides
- -Instructor can use as well if they wanted
- -Examples of how to use it (buttons on the right side)
 - pink-important button
 - green-assignment button

- -Filtering makes it clean (no background or disruptions)
- -You can synch hands free from cell phone in class to your computer at Home
